## Children's Services

- Public computers with internet access and wireless networking.
- Inter-Library Loan – if we don't have a book, we can try to get it from any other library in the state.
- Adult book discussions – the discussion is held on the last Monday of each month at 7:00 pm and the books are provided for you.
- An active Friends of the Library group. New members are always welcome. For more information ask the Librarians.
- Many special events are held throughout the year for all ages including guest speakers, local authors, craft fairs, and much more.
- Free and discounted passes to many area museums, such as: American Independence Museum, Canterbury Shaker Village, New England Aquarium, Childrens Museum of NH, Currier Museum of Art, McAuliffe Shepard Discovery Center, Museum of Fine Arts Boston, Museum of Science, Seacoast Science Center, SEE Science Center, Strawberry Banke, and York's Wild Kingdom.

**Story hours** for pre-school children are held on Tuesdays at 10:30 am and 2:00 pm and Wednesdays at 10:30 am. During school vacations and summertime, the schedule is variable, but watch the Brentwood Newsletter or check out our website for information. All ages are welcome and there is no sign up required. There are always stories, games, crafts, and plenty of fun!



The **Summer Reading Program**, sponsored by the Friends of the Library, is especially well attended.
